ITEM 5.49 POLITICAL CAMPAIGNING IN TRI-PAR ESTATES

A. Candidates for any public office and/or referendum shall follow Policy 5.41 Signs and Advertising for Temporary Political Signage. They shall be prohibited from the following:

- 1. Placing posters on bulletin boards or clubhouse walls.
- 2. Placing signs on common grounds or within road right-of-way.

B. Candidates for Tri-Par Estates office of trustee shall be permitted to speak at a rally, coffee, or other such scheduled meeting called for this purpose. They are prohibited from posting signs on bulletin boards or walls. They may write a short article for the Tri-Par Newsletter about themselves, their qualifications and why they are running for office. Residents are permitted to collect signatures on a petition for office of trustee. Candidates for office must follow all State, Federal and District regulations regarding political advertising, electioneering communications, and campaigning rules promulgated by the Florida Division of Elections.
